Public Budget Information Webcast

- Webcast presented noted the presentation was recorded
- Board is facing financial challenges that date back to 1975
- Most of the budget is identified for specific needs to maintain the quality of programs
- Operating under a multi-year financial recovery plan with the Ministry of Education and there is a \$36.5M projected deficit
- Overall decline in enrollment, however Kindergarten enrollment for St. Albert for 2024-2025 is looking good
- Waiting for funding announcement for 2024-2025
